2019 will soon be over and its been a busy year for teaching many aspiring gilders in methods from glass gilding to water gilding for frames and architecture to mordant gilding as used by a wide variety of fine artists, from painters to explorers of mixed media. 2020 will welcome the new 3-day class: an Introduction to Gold Leaf Restoration, an intensive workshop designed for those interested in restoration and repairs for picture frames, furniture, and gilded wooden objects. We'll cover making traditional gesso and gesso putty for infills, mould-making and casting for missing ornamentation, and the blending of newly-laid gold leaf. Austrian artist Gustav Klimt, symbolist painter of such highly regarded works of art such as Portrait of Adele Bloch-Bauer I (as depicted in the film *Woman of Gold*), *The Kiss*, and *Beethoven Frieze*, was instrumental in the creation of the Vienna Secessionist movement. His work and history we discussed in earlier issues as a commemoration of his death in 1918 and his impact on the artworld relating to his ten year 'golden period' where the use of gilding played a major role in his work, more of which we will continue to explore in the coming year.

To further commemorate Klimt's contribution to art and his intriguing use of gilding directly within his paintings and murals - and as a fun way to engage us all! - we have now the long-awaited Winter Klimt Quiz!

The prize is a copy of the book, simply





Introduction to Traditional Water Gilding

Be guided through each of the steps of this beautiful, ancient method of gold leaf gilding for use on such objects as picture frames, furniture, and architectural detail. Students will learn to prepare rabbit skin glue, traditional gesso, and clay bole grounds followed by

*laying and burnishing genuine 22 kt gold leaf.
Individual guidance is provided in developing the
skills to handle gold leaf using the gilder's tools and
brushes. Basic elements of toning will be
demonstrated*


