




Advanced Techniques For Traditional Water Gilding: Gilding Class Spotlight

The newest Online class that I'm very excited about sharing is ***Advanced Techniques for Traditional Water Gilded Panels*** which meets Online each Friday for four weeks, June 16 - July 7.



Egg Tempera Gilded Panel painting was popular in Florence during the 13th - 18th c as well as in earlier use in the realm of sacred Iconography. Eventually Oils became the more popular paint medium with the contemporary use of Acrylics sharing popular use today alongside oil paint and a well-deserved resurgence of interest in egg tempera among Fine artists.

The Water Gilded Surface in contrast maintains its place as the most beautiful and versatile method of the gilded surface for gilded panel painting and Icons. However, as gilding ages, certain changes take place. Gold leaf wears away to some degree depending upon handling and environmental conditions., more so on areas that are unburnished as burnishing not only makes water gilded gold leaf shine but it also compresses the leaf into the underlying clay bole ground increasing its durability. The satin-toned unburnished areas of water gilding does not share the

distinction of this compression from the agate stone, therefore it tends to wear away quicker than burnished sections. The use of a weakened rabbit skin glue size (RSG) plays a role in the protection of these satin areas as well as a matting agent offering added contrast to the design element of gilding.

The wearing-away of gold leaf, whether on panels, frames, furniture, architectural accoutrements, or other water gilded objects creates at times a beautiful interplay of clay color and gold, of overlaps and veining in the gilded leaf. While this can be replicated somewhat with the use of Fine steel wool, my preference, however, is the use of a paste made of ethyl or denatured alcohol and Calcium Carbonate, the filler we use to make Gesso. It offers the characteristic of reducing the brilliancy of the shine of burnished gold leaf allowing for greater ability to view the leaf during reduction as the gold layer becomes gradually thinner with a delicate and controlled pressure revealing the underlying clay.

These fundamentals are taught in the new Advanced Techniques class along with a simple but valuable approach to Toning the gilded surface to replicate age through the use of a choice of an aqueous raw umber wash or oil-based applied patina.

Spot Gilding - gilding small areas where the gold may require touchups due to the stray remnants from pinholes or air bubbles, cracks in the leaf, or simply areas where the gold leaf did not stick due to too dry of an application - is performed with a small, wet mop brush, RSG-infused gilding water, and very small pieces of gold leaf.

The final element in the creation of the patination process for Water Gilding as well as for optional

physical protection is Shellac. Although not used in all countries historically, I find it to be the most versatile of protective coatings for gilding as it can be softened by buffing with Rottenstone, offer physical protection of leaf, reduce the brilliancy of bright, burnished gold leaf, and apply a more subdued topcoating than the harsher varnishes and lacquers. It can also be tinted with dyes and pigments for additional toning approaches. During class you'll learn to prepare your own shellac from flakes and alcohol and apply it with a Pad, similar in approach to French Polishing.

I am fortunate to have had the opportunity these many years to discover, apply, and refine these techniques which are used in traditional water gilding, techniques that are valuable for the Panel Gilding Fine Artist that can be used alone or in combination to help you define your vision for your work.

Goings On...In The Gilding Artworld

And much gratitude to the students who waited patiently until the pandemic reached the phase where borders could re-open and schedules realigned. Many thanks too to the students who discovered the classes of this ancient art form along the way while rumblings can be heard of a return once again. So for those who missed this round...*stay tuned!*

Two months ago I had the pleasure of meeting students in New York during the early Spring mini-series at our Hosts **Sepp Leaf Products** and the **Isabel O'Neil**

Studio, always an exciting venture to return 'home' to The City. gilding. To become more familiar with Klimt and the history of this painting you can visit the Neue Galeri website and watch an intriguing Youtube presentation by **Renée Price**, the Art Director at the Neue. (And yes, I admit, **Café Sabarsky** downstairs is also an absolute Must when going to the Galeri at Fifth Avenue and 86th!)

An excellent next step for the Students of Traditional Water Gilded Panels!

Learn advanced methods including rubbing the gold leaf on traditional water gilded panels for an aged-appearance. Also discover how to touch up and blend spot gilded repairs, tone for antiquing in a light to dark Umber, apply a rabbit skin glue solution to gold leaf for protection and as a matting agent, and mix and pad your own shellac. Rubbing gold leaf is a technique often used in water gilding for objects such as frames and furniture to simulate age and sometimes to simply to create a complex and beautiful look that exposes the underlying clay and gesso. Considering that water gilded panels go back to at least the 12thc as seen in some beautiful examples of 13th - 18thc Egg Tempera Water Gilded Panels at the Uffizi Gallery in Florence and the Fricke Museum in New York, learning this technique as a gilder of Contemporary Water Gilded Panels is an indispensable technique for adding an aged-appearance or an added level of tonal complexity to your gilding. A paste of calcium carbonate and alcohol is used to great affect.
